Mentee Overview

Overview and program purpose:

The Community Connections Youth Mentoring Program helps empower youth in our community to make positive life choices that enable them to maximize their potential. The Youth Mentoring Program uses adult volunteers to commit to supporting, guiding, and being a friend to a young person. By becoming part of the social network of adults and community members who care about the youth, the mentor can help youth develop and reach positive academic, career, and personal goals.

Time and duration commitments:

- Must reside in Revelstoke
- Willing to communicate with mentor regularly
- Commit to a minimum of eight hours a month with mentor
- Parents/guardians and mentee communicate with program coordinator 1x/month

Eligibility requirements:

- Be 10-18 years of age
- Demonstrate a desire to participate and be willing to adhere to all Community Connections Youth Mentoring Program policies and procedures
- Obtain parental / guardian permission and ongoing support for participation

Screening requirements:

- Parents / guardians complete written application
- Contact & Information Release
- Mentee Interest Survey
- Personal interview with program coordinator

Sequence of events to becoming a mentee

- 1) Eligibility
- 2) Interest
- 3) Application
- 4) Screening process
- 5) Matching with mentor
- 6) Support and supervision
