Position Title: Summer Day Camp Leader

Program Summary:

The Children's Summer Day Camp operates 5 days a week through the months of July and August. It is an inclusive program for children and youth 6-11 years of age. The activities and events of each week are related to the theme for the week.

Job Description:

The Summer Day Camp Head Leader will run an inclusive summer day camp program and provide supervision and leadership to children, youth and camp staff. The ideal Head Leader will create relationships with community partners, participating families, and fellow camp leaders.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Create, supervise and provide leadership to a staff team
2. Research and develop program ideas and activities
3. Create and distribute advertising (posters, brochures, radio, and online)
4. Identify and secure program resources, including funding sources, materials and supplies
5. Develop weekly program plans that are informed by program budget
6. Provide leadership and direction to children
7. Interact with the children and assist all children to participate in all program activities
8. Communicate with parents about their children
9. Create and collect weekly parent and camper evaluations
10. Create "Thank You" collage for those who provide donations
